Make comparisons within and across books	
Read a range of modern fiction, classic literature and books from other cultures and traditions	
Discuss understanding of complex texts including exploring meaning of words in context	
Identify the main themes and conventions of a text	
Ask questions to improve understanding of texts	
Summarise large proportions of text into key events	
Make predictions based on details stated and implied	
Make book recommendations, giving detailed reasons for choice	
Participate in formal presentations and debates about reading	
Identify how language, structure and presentation can contribute to meanings	
Read, recognise and recite a variety of poetry	
Provide reasoned justifications for opinions
