As many of you will remember, I wrote to you in February 2017 indicating the Department for Education's agreement in principle to the establishment of Inspiring Primaries Academy Trust. On 1st June 2017 the following schools will be part of Inspiring Primaries Academy Trust:

All Saints CE Primary School, Sapcote
Gilmorton Chandler CE Primary School
John Wycliffe Primary School
Ullesthorpe CE Primary School

The conversion of the other church and community schools intending to join the multi-academy trust has been delayed, but we hope they will be able to join us on 1st July 2017.

A multi academy trust's board of trustees is accountable in law for all decisions about its academies. However, this does not mean that the board is required to make all the decisions itself. Each school is currently overseen by a governing body. These will remain as the 'local governing body'.

Our guiding principles are as follows:
