Dear Parents,

Class 3 will be attending Forest School every Monday afternoon 1:30-3:00, starting on the 10th September and finishing on Monday 10th December 2018. The forest School is on our site and aims to give children the unique opportunity of experiencing play and learning in a controlled outdoor environment. Forest School is the name for an approach to educating children in the outdoors on a regular basis. This work will have a strong emphasis on raising all children's confidence and independence and developing the children's awareness and understanding of the outdoors.

An integral part of the Forest School experience is that children will be **outdoors in all weathers**, with the exception of very high winds and thunder storms. To help achieve this, please provide your child with suitable outdoor clothes on a Monday so that they can change into this for the Forest School session, this would include a waterproof coat and trousers. We ask you to supply wellington boots, and on sunny days, a sun hat and sun cream; on colder days, warm clothing. Please bear in mind that your child could possibly get muddy so they are free to change into old clothing if your wish!
