Parent Governor Election Ballot

We have received 2 nominations for 1 parent governor vacancy and are therefore required to hold a secret ballot.

You may vote for up to as many candidates as number of vacant posts by putting an X in the box against the name of the person for whom you wish to vote. Each parent should vote on a separate form. If your ballot paper is lost or spoilt you may apply to the headteacher/principal for a duplicate.

Attached to the ballot paper is the personal statement from each candidate outlining their skills, suitability and commitment to the role. When you have completed your ballot paper please return it to school. **You may return it either by your child or by post but it must be received in the school office no later than 3:30pm on Monday 1st April 2019. Any ballot papers received after this date will not be considered.**

When the ballot paper has been received in school it will be placed in a sealed box or container and kept secure to be opened on the day of the count.

The headteacher is the Returning Officer and will be responsible for the conduct of the election. The electoral method of counting will be that the candidate with the highest number of votes will be elected.

The count will take place on *Tuesday 2nd April 2019 at 1pm.* Candidates are invited to be present at the count or send a representative.

The headteacher will inform all parents of the outcome of the election via *text message and letter.*
