People are God's treasured possessions, made in His image. Jesus shows what God is like. Stories about Jesus are found in the Bible. Connect the baby Jesus with the adult Jesus.</i>	<i>Thematic units of Special places, stories and Belonging. This is the first sustained in-depth study of a faith other than Christianity.</i>	<i>Jesus' believers thought he was King (Messiah/Christ) and sent by God to save or rescue people. Easter is a mixture of sorrow, joy, reflection and hope. Jesus gives his followers hope of forgiveness. Jesus is the bridge between people and God.</i>	Previous learning in Part 1 (Spring 1) : What God means to Muslims and Who the Prophet Muhammed was and why he is important to Muslims.	Christians believe Jesus brings good news to everyone: being loved by God and forgiveness for doing wrong. Jesus is a friend to the poor and friendless.
