Re: Consultation on Admission Arrangements from Academic Year 2026/2027

I am writing to notify you of a consultation on the school's admissions policy. The 6-week consultation period will run from Thursday 10th October 2024 – Thursday 21st November 2024: during this time parents, colleagues and interested parties are invited to express their views and any concerns about the the admissions arrangements at Ullesthorpe C E Primary School.

In accordance with the DfE's 2021 statutory 'School Admissions Code' guidance, as a school we must consult on our admissions arrangements when changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years.

A full version of the new policy that outlines the admission arrangements is included with this letter. A copy is also available on the school web site or a hard copy can be requested from the office.

In accordance with the School Admissions Code 2021, the consultation will run for at least six weeks and as an interested party at Ullesthorpe C E Primary School, we are keen to hear your views. Therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation if you have any concerns in this matter.

All responses to the consultation should be made in writing and submitted before 12:00pm on Thursday 21st November 2024 to: Ullesthorpe@ipat.uk or to The Governing Board, Ullesthorpe C E Primary School, Ashby Road, Ullesthorpe, Leics LE10 5DN.

Please note that written responses should outline your personal details, including your name, address and relationship to the school.

At the end of the consultation period, the Governing Board will consider all responses. The outcome of the consultation will be published on the school website as soon as possible following a decision being reached by the board. Hard copies of the final report will be made available on request to all respondents of the consultation.
